## 2008 Scholarship Program

Newfoundland Labrador Housing (Housing) will award a total of six \$1,000 Youth Scholarships to children of Housing tenants\*. Two scholarships will be awarded in each of the following regions: Avalon/East, Central, and Western/Labrador.

### What makes me eligible to apply for a Youth Scholarship?

To be eligible to apply for Housing's Youth Scholarship Program, you must be a child of a Housing tenant\* and meet the following eligibility requirements:

- 1. Must have been a Level III high school student in 2008 (completing Level III in June 2008).
- 2. Must be attending any post-secondary institution approved by the Newfoundland and Labrador Department of Education on a full-time basis in the fall of 2008.

Youth scholarships will be awarded based on the results of the Newfoundland and Labrador Department of Education Scholarship Score which is derived from a student's performance on the Newfoundland and Labrador Provincial Public Exams.

#### Please Note

Applications for the Youth Scholarship Program must be postmarked no later than **August 31**, **2008.**

\* For the purpose of this scholarship program, a Housing "tenant" is defined as someone who is either:

- 1) renting from Housing and whose signature appears on the rental lease,
- 2) receiving a rent supplement from Housing,
- 3) receiving a mortgage subsidy from Housing and whose signature appears on the mortgage. document, or
- 4) living in Co-op housing or Community-Based housing which is subsidized by Newfoundland Labrador Housing.
